75th Annual Meeting

The Logan Soil and Water Conservation District held their 75th Annual Meeting, September 13, 2018 at Winner's Harvest Barn, 7075 St. Rt. 47 W., DeGraff, Ohio. The election for two supervisor positions began at 6:15 PM and ended at 7:15 PM. The Logan Soil and Water Conservation District Annual Meeting was held in conjunction with the Logan County Farm Bureau Annual Meeting.

Supervisors present included: Frank Phelps, Joe Ramsey, and David Knight.
