This month for the activity night, the kids at Chippewa and Russells Point did some experimenting with soda pop. We first discussed how harmful it is to different parts of your body. We talked about the sugar and calories in soda and different uses that people use it for, besides drinking. We talked about the amount of exercise you would need to perform to work off the calories from one 20-ounce bottle of soda. We then discussed how it is made and did several experiments to show how much CO₂ it contains. This led into a discussion of why it explodes when you shake up a can before opening it. Each of the kids were then given a 12-ounce bottle of soda to drop 3 Mentos mints into it. The CO₂ reacted with the Mentos and shot the pop out of the bottle into the air. We then used a 2 liter bottle of soda and dropped 7 Mentos in it to compare it to their eruption. The kids were amazed how high up it shot the soda into the air. Next month we will be discussing air pressure and doing experiments to demonstrate this.
